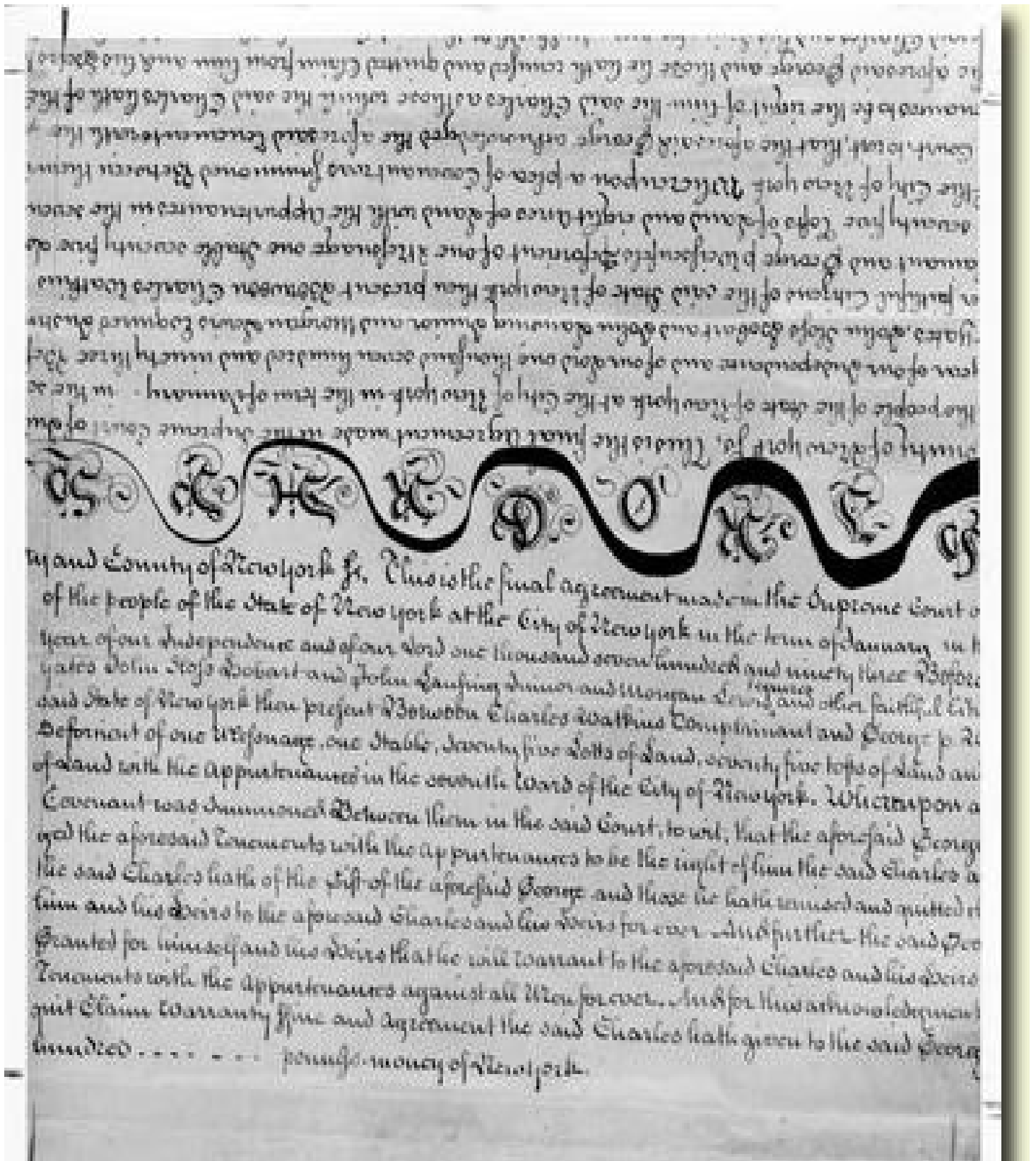


The Kings' Jews

yours John Stos Robert and John Lansing Junior and Morgan Lewis and other faithful Men
said State of New York then present Robert Charles Matthias Comptroler and George P. R.
Defendant of our Defendant one Stable seven five lots of land seven five lots of land and
of land with the appurtenances in the seventh ward of the City of New York. Whereupon a
Covenant was drawn and between them in the said Court, to wit, that the aforesaid George
and the aforesaid Tenements with the appurtenances to be the right of him the said Charles
the said Charles hath of the gift of the aforesaid George and those he hath received and quieted
him and his heirs to the aforesaid Charles and his heirs for ever. And further the said George
granted for himself and his heirs that he will warrant to the aforesaid Charles and his heirs
Tenements with the appurtenances against all Men for ever. And for this acknowledgement
quit claim warranty fine and agreement the said Charles hath given to the said George
hundred pounds money of New York.
